



Festival Volunteer Positions

Time Commitment: minimum of 3 hours, and more, depending on your availability

Organizational Overview: Muskoka Pride is a registered not for profit organization that exists to provide visibility of and positive inclusions of the LGBTQ community of Muskoka through planning and hosting pride events throughout the community.

Position Purpose: Festival Volunteers help to make the Muskoka Pride Festival a success. Working under the direction of the Volunteer Coordinator, volunteers will take on multiple tasks in the preparation of and running of the Festival. Commitments from volunteers will be during the Festival Week (July 20 – 29), as well as in the months leading up to it (beginning as early as April).

Volunteer Roles:

April / May / June: assisting the fundraising team, collecting donations from local businesses, creating a parade float, putting up posters, distributing marketing materials

July: assisting with setup/takedown and facilitating events during the Festival Week, coordinating carpooling, photography, general participation

*****We will be most in need of volunteers on Sunday, July 29th for the Parade and Picnic.**

Parade: parade marshals, organizing the participants, walking along the route, general tasks

Picnic: greeters, setup and take down (lifting may be required), First Aid, administration, general tasks
