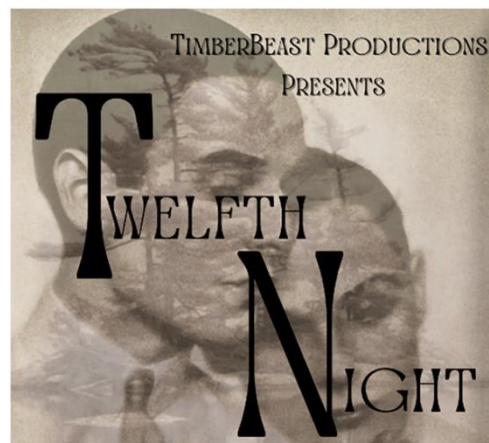

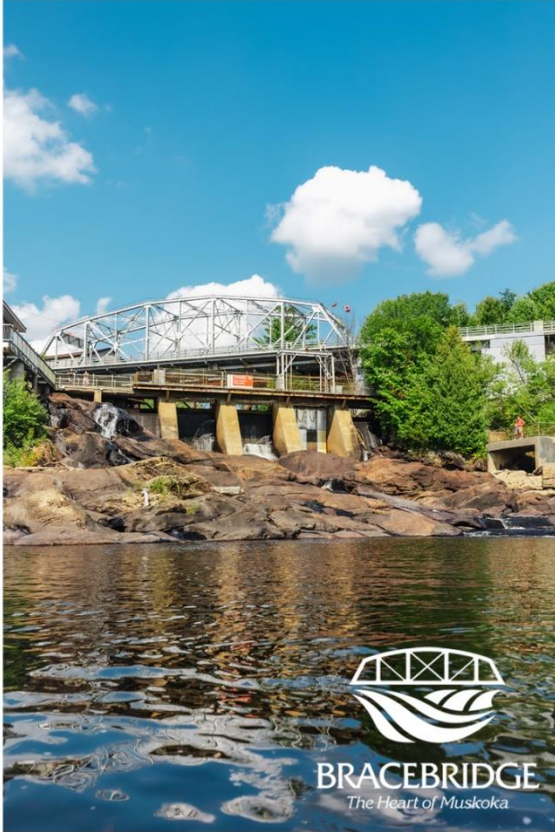


Pull up your lawn chair and take in the sights and sounds of a Gravenhurst from the past – one of lumber mills, music halls and clean air that put our home on the map.

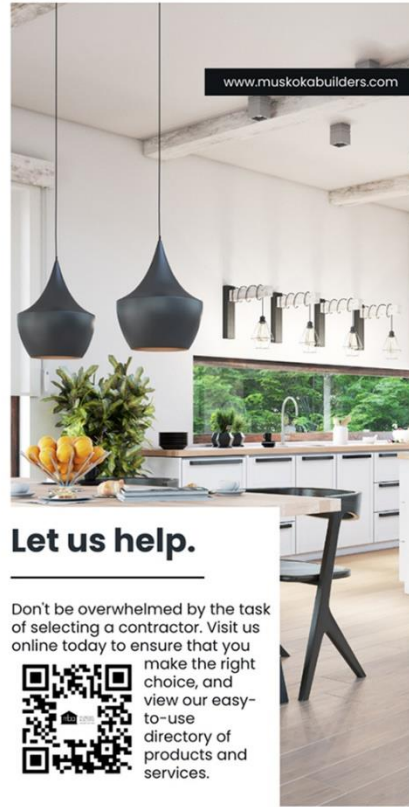
